Residents have told us they are concerned that graffiti and fly-tipping attract even more anti-social behaviour. There are reports that people urinate in the alleyways where rubbish is dumped.

Lib Dem **Adam Keenan** says, "A lot of these problems happen because there is a lack of enforcement by the Council and lack of coordination with Network Rail land. There needs to be a joined-up approach to eradicate these problems for good."
