Lammas Park SuDS drainage scheme UPDATE

Ealing Labour rejects Lib Dem Opposition calls for an independent review into the Lamma Park fiasco



Ealing Liberal Democrat Opposition Councillors have been trying to get answers about the SuDS drainage scheme failures in Lammas Park.

Large sections of the park have been out of use for TWO years.

At July's Full Council meeting, Ealing Labour rejected a Lib Dem motion to commission an independent review into the Lammas Park SuDS drainage works.

Local Lib Dem campaigner **Matt Mellor** has been listening to your concerns and working with Lib Dem Opposition Councillors to get the answers residents deserve.

Lib Dem campaigner Matt Mellor said, "Whilst there is merit in the scheme, the scheme has clearly been mismanaged by the Labour Council, and it is really important that lessons are learned before the Council wastes even more public money on similar schemes."

"As the Official Opposition in Ealing Council, only the Liberal Democrats will continue to hold Ealing Labour to account to provide a voice for the local community in Walpole ward."
